

RESOLUTION NO. 25-182

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CANYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING INTERFACILITY AMBULANCE OPERATION WITH ASCENT MEDICAL TRANSPORT**

The following resolution and order was considered and adopted by the Canyon County, Idaho Board of Commissioners ("Board") on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2025.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Van Beek and the second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board resolves as follows:

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board authority "to do and perform all other acts . . . which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government"; and

**WHEREAS**, Canyon County Code 02-09-19 requires District authorization by resolution of the Board for operation of an ambulance, ambulance service or medical transfers within Canyon County;

**WHEREAS**, District authorization shall meet the requirements of IDAPA 16.02.03 Rules Governing Emergency Medical Services and its subsequent amendment(s);




**WHEREAS**, Canyon County Ambulance District Chief Michael Stowell approves the District's use of Ascent Medical Transport and requests the Board's authorization of such use for interfacility ambulance transports between healthcare facilities as requested by Ascent Medical Transport in Exhibit A attached hereto.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY RESOLVES**, approves and authorizes, in accordance with Canyon County Code 02-09-19 and IDAPA 16.02.03, the use of Ascent Medical Transport for interfacility ambulance transports between healthcare facilities.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD, that this resolution shall be effective this 25th day of September, 2025.

Dear Commissioners,

On behalf of Ascent Medical Transport, I respectfully submit this request for authorization to operate within Canyon County for the purpose of conducting interfacility ambulance transports between healthcare facilities, as provided for under Canyon County Code § 02-09-19 (“District Authorization Required For Operation”).

Our agency is fully licensed by the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare, Bureau of EMS and Preparedness as an Emergency Medical Services agency, authorized to provide ambulance transport services up to the Critical Care level, in compliance with IDAPA 16.02.03. All operational, staffing, equipment, and training standards required by Idaho state law are met and maintained.

In alignment with § 02-09-19, we seek the Board’s formal authorization by resolution to conduct non-911, interfacility ambulance transports originating within Canyon County. This request does not include 911 emergency response but is limited to scheduled and unscheduled transfers of patients between licensed healthcare facilities, as coordinated by those facilities.

Granting this authorization would allow our organization to:

- Support Canyon County hospitals and healthcare providers with safe, timely, and clinically appropriate transport options;
- Operate under the regulatory authority and oversight of both the Canyon County Ambulance District and the Idaho EMS Bureau; and
- Ensure compliance with all applicable county ordinances and state EMS regulations.

We appreciate the Board’s consideration of this request and stand ready to provide any supporting documentation the Commissioners may require, including copies of our current Idaho EMS Agency License, insurance certificates, and policies demonstrating adherence to state and county EMS standards.
