

RESOLUTION NO. 25-186

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CANYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS CONSENTING TO THE SALE OF
SURPLUS COUNTY PROPERTY**

The following Resolution was considered and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Canyon County, Idaho on the 30th day of September, 2025.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Van Beek, the Board resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board the authority “to do and perform all other acts . . . which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government;” and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-807 authorizes the Board to manage county property subject to restrictions including, but not limited to, those described in Idaho Code § 31-808; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-808(9), the Board of County Commissioners may grant any item of personal property, with or without compensation, to any political subdivision or the State of Idaho if such grant of property is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 permits the sale of personal property whenever any elective county officer determines that such personal property is of no further use to the county; and

WHEREAS, Canyon County is in possession of such personal property, described below, which has a fair trade-in value total of \$17,700.00 as determined by the Canyon County Fleet Manager, and has been taken out of service by the Canyon County Fleet Manager and is now surplus property:

- 2018 Ford Interceptor Utility AWD; VIN1FM5K8AR3JGA58104; 129,633 miles
- 2018 Ford Interceptor Utility AWD; VIN 1FM5K8AR5JGA58105; 134,606 miles
- 2018 Ford Interceptor Utility AWD; VIN 1FM5K8AR0JGA58108; 138,818 miles



Based on these findings, the Board further finds that sale of the personal property is in the public interest pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-808(9).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Board of County Commissioners hereby consents to the sale of such personal property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Resolution shall be effective this 30th day of September, 2025.
