Upon a motion by Commissioner Van Beek and a second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board voted unanimously to enter into Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206(1)(d) and (f) regarding records that are exempt from public disclosure and to communicate with legal counsel regarding pending/imminently likely litigation revolving around the animal shelter. The Executive Session began at 10:43 a.m. and concluded at 11:37 a.m.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Van Beek and a second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board voted unanimously that with consensus of the Cities of Nampa and Caldwell, Canyon County will continue to move forward with West Valley through this fiscal year, September 30, 2026 – and the parties have agreed to a join press release that will be issued as soon as possible based on that agreement to assist with animals.
