MEETING TO CONSIDER MATTERS RELATED TO COUNTY ASSISTANCE

The Board met today at 11:02 a.m. to consider matters related to County assistance. Present were Commissioners Leslie Van Beek, Brad Holton, and Zach Brooks; Case Manager Kellie George; and Deputy Clerk Diana Hoffman.

Ms. George presented **Case No. 2026-17**. The decedent passed on April 4. The cremation application for financial aid from the County was submitted to County Assistance on April 9. The funeral home reached back out to County Assistance to notify them that a family member had paid for the cremation. The application has been withdrawn.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Van Beek and a second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board voted unanimously to deny application no. 2026-17, which had been withdrawn and the charges for the cremation have been paid by family, which eliminates the County as a payer of last resort.

Case No. 2015-999 has received a request for release of the lien. The applicant has satisfied his debt to the County.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Van Beek and a second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board voted unanimously to release the liens on Case No. 2015-999 with thanks to the person who received the loan from the County for fulfilling the obligation of that note and paying it off.
